Riofisa is to invest 185 Million Euros in a new shopping centre at PortAventura

- The centre will form part of the PortAventura resort on the Costa Dorada in Tarragona.
- “PortAventura Village” will feature advanced concepts in architectural design and new leisure options. It will offer something to suit the whole family with especially designed garden areas and transit zones.

Madrid, 25th April 2007.- Riofisa signed an agreement to purchase land from PortAventura yesterday, just a few hours before its Annual General Shareholders Meeting. The plot occupies approximately 95,000 square metres and it will house the “PortAventura Village” shopping and entertainments centre.

The new complex, resulting from investment totalling 185 Million Euros, will form part of the PortAventura Resort, occupying a prime location, near the new railway station.

The Centre will incorporate design features reflecting Mediterranean architecture and will offer new concepts in leisure with areas dedicated to dining, transit, thematic areas, gardens and multi-adventure facilities, all playing an important role. Furthermore, leading brandnames will be on offer to ensure the maximum quality for visitors. The aim is to make “PortAventura Village” a reference point for family entertainment and leisure. The Centre will have 2 car parks with space for over 2000 vehicles.

The centre is planned to open to the public in 2010.
